When was the first electric signal box invented?

The first electric signal box goes into service at Pont de Lyon,near Bercy,by the Chemin de fer company. From 1912onwards,the Compagnie des Signaux became independent and designed its own electrical signalling devices for railways. First contract to maintain the signalling system on the Paris metro.
