Who owns Brunei energy services & trading (best)?

Brunei Energy Services and Trading (BEST) is the national oil company owned by the Brunei government. The company was granted all mineral rights in eight prime onshore and offshore petroleum blocks totaling 20,552 sq. km. PB manages contracts with Shell and Petronas, which are exploring Brunei's onshore and deep-water offshore blocks.

Who owns the solar plant in Brunei?

The solar plant in Brunei is currently operated and maintained by BSP. Agnete Johnsgaard-Lewis, BSP Managing Director and Shell Country Chair in Brunei, shared this information.

How much does energy cost in Brunei?

As of 1st January 2012, the Energy Department of Brunei introduced a 4-tier tariff structure, ranging from \$0.0075 to \$0.09 per kWh for residential customers, and from \$0.037 to \$0.15 per kWh for commercial customers. 3
