Are sales agents bound by contracts in Cameroon?

Sales agents can be bound by contracts, but these may be difficult to enforce in case of problems. International companies (DHL, UPS, and FedEx) dominate express delivery in Cameroon. These companies can deliver from the United States within seven days, though their reach to cities outside regional capitals is limited.
