What payment methods will Canadian businesses accept in 2023?

Source: Statistics Canada. Canadian Survey on Business Conditions, third quarter of 2023 (Table 33-10-0703-01). Businesses plan to accept more digital and contactless payment methods in the next 12 months, including Interac e-transfer (20.2%), electronic funds transfer (EFT) (10.2%), wire transfer (9.2%) and debit cards (7.9%).

What payment methods do Canadian businesses accept?

In Canada, 7 in 10 businesses accept cheque (70.1%) as a method of payment and 6 in 10 businesses accept electronic funds transfer (EFT) (60.8%). Furthermore, over half of businesses accept cash (53.4%) or credit cards (52.4%) and half of businesses accept Interac e-transfer (50.0%) as a method of payment.

What is the sample size of the Canadian payment method survey?
