Where is Estonia's largest battery storage facility located?

The flagship battery storage project commenced operations on February 1, only days before cutting ties with the Russian power grid. Estonian state-owned energy company Eesti Energia has inaugurated the nation's largest battery energy storage facility at the Auvere industrial complex in Ida-Viru County.

Can storage systems help reduce energy consumption in Estonia?

Estonia's climate minister, Yoko Alender, emphasized the role of storage systems in this transition, stating, "Estonia has a clear goal - by 2030, the amount of electricity we consume must come from renewable sources.

Where is Eesti Energia's battery energy storage system located?

Eesti Energia officially inaugurated the 26.5MW/53.1MWh battery energy storage system last week (26 March), located at the Auvere industrial power plant complex in Ida-Virumaa.

However, the project has been online since 1 February, in time for the Baltic region's decoupling from the Russian grid a week later.
