Whether you add ten days and increment the month or increment the month and add ten days, the result should be the same. The fundamental issue is of course that a month is not a fixed ...

I would read the first as referring to a deadline, the second referring to a total accumulation of days spent. For example, "This project must be finished within 30 days" is different than "This ...
